AMENDMENT N°1 TO THE NOTICE OF RACE

1 Rules

The race is governed by:

Read: 1.1 The rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2017-2020, with the following amendments:

- RRS 52 (Manual Power): modified for [single handed and double handed crews](#): «[Single handed](#) and double handed crews are authorised to use power other than manual power to run an autopilot that changes the heading of the boat. This power can be used to operate the ballast and/or canting keel system. For multihulls only, this power can be used to operate an anticapsize system that fully or partially releases the sheets. This system must in no case enable the sail to be sheeted in».
- RRS 55 (Trash disposal): add a second sentence: «However, disposing of small quantities of what is generally considered biodegradable material overboard, such as fruit peel or elastics and strands of wool used to set a sail is permitted».

3. Eligibility

Read : **The race is open to all boats in design category (CE) A or B. Boats which are not CE marked must be classified in division 245 and be capable of sailing in Sailing Category A and B. Boats built prior to the CE (1/07/1996) standard must be registered in the 3rd Sailing category minimum.**

- Section 3.03 of the OSR: Hull construction standards: This chapter applies in full.

- Section 3.04 of the OSR: Stability - Monohulls:

This means that for boats for which the 1st in the series was built after 1/07/1996, the CE Certification applies.

The CE plate on boats (CAT A) and the CIN N° engraved on the back of the hull (starboard) certifies that the boat complies with STIX and AVS.

3.1.2 For the DRHEAM-CUP 400 :

Read : • CLASSIC YACHTS JCH rule (JCH 2020 Rating equal or above 9.400), [boats with a rating below 9.4000 wanting to take part in the DRHEAM-CUP 400 should contact the organiser.](#)

3.2 CREWS

3.2.1 : **Read :** CLASSIC For the DRHEAM-CUP 400, the crew must be of 2 minimum [except the Figaro 3 \(Figaro Bénéteau Class\), who will race single handed.](#)
