Infiniti 52 Tulikettu (abandonment): First time offshore In May 2022 for the delivery from Cascais to Portsmouth

- Learned a huge amount about sailing high performance boats and the systems they have on board.
- We abandoned ship 200nm from shore (out of helicopter range) and 100nm from the nearest ship
- Even if it wasn't the right decision on board or in hindsight, the understanding was the boat was sinking and from this, I now know that I am very calm, and perform efficiently, under pressure and in an extreme crisis.
- Also gained a great deal of understanding in managing a sinking/water ingress situation, methods of stopping it, emergency procedures & what to check for if on a boat for the first time and other proper preparations.
